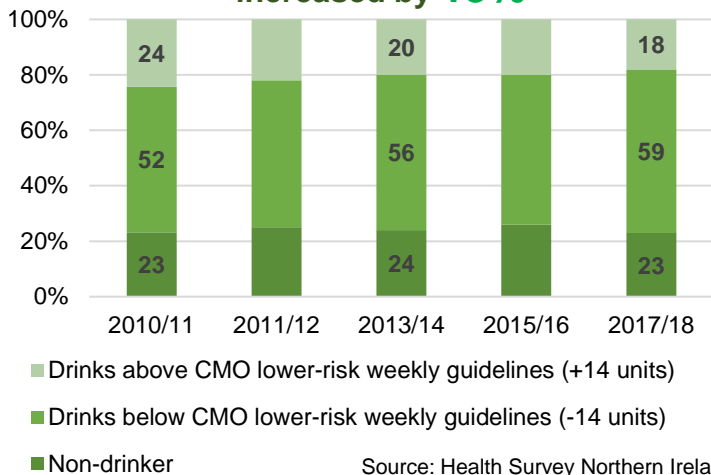


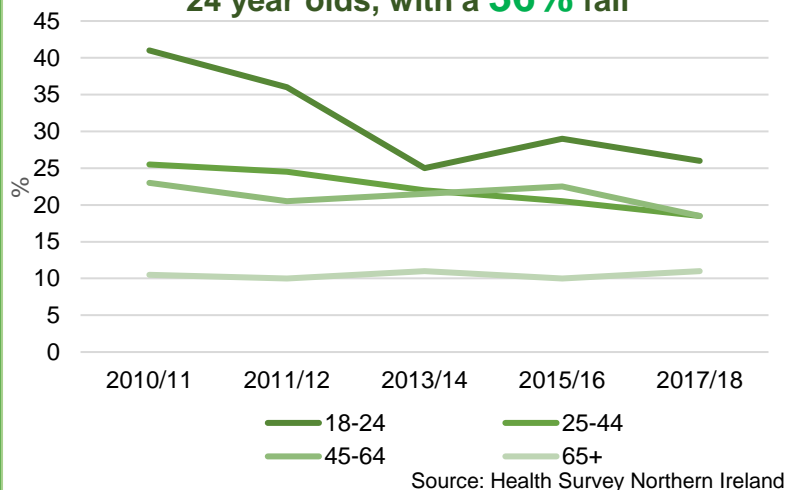
Alcohol trends in Northern Ireland

- Increased risk drinking continues to fall across all age groups and all areas of Northern Ireland, most notably 18-24 year olds
- Underage drinking has also significantly fallen
- Both alcohol-related violence and perceptions of alcohol-related anti-social behaviour continue to decline

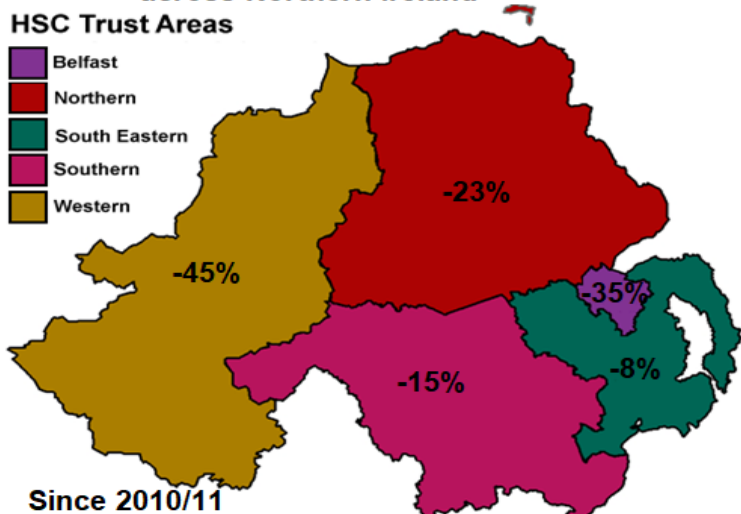
Increased risk drinking has fallen by **25%**, while responsible drinking has increased by **13%**



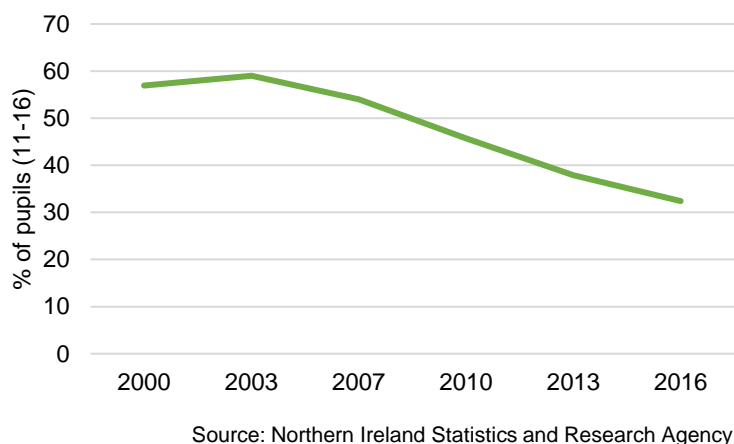
Increased risk drinking is falling across all age groups, most notably among 18-24 year olds, with a **36%** fall



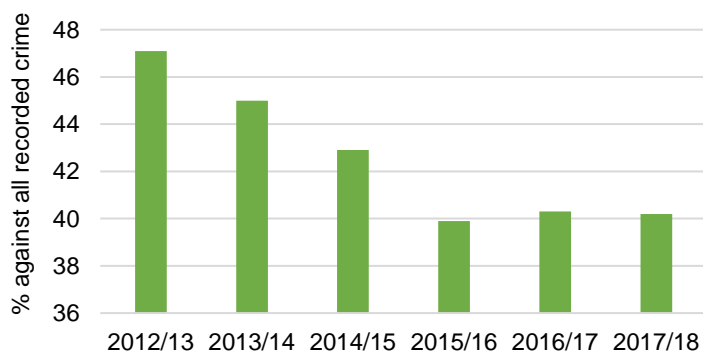
Increased risk drinking is in decline across Northern Ireland



Underage drinking has fallen **43%** since 2000



Alcohol-related violence has fallen **14%** since 2012



There has been a **44%** fall in those saying that people being drunk or rowdy in public places is a big problem in their area
